### INTENT- What pupils will learn at West Park?

All KS2 pupils will follow the Language Angels scheme of work to learn French	The four key language learning skills (L,S,R,W) will be taught.	Grammar will be covered in an age-appropriate way and be transferable for any future MFL learning.	Phonics will be covered both implicitly and explicitly.	Pupils will learn to appreciate the diversity of cultures and languages in a multi-lingual society.	Pupils will develop their curiosity about languages and also celebrate different languages
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### IMPLEMENTATION- What teaching activities are planned at West Park?

<p><b>Planning-</b> French is planned using the Language Angels scheme. The unit planner has progression built in within each unit, throughout the year and from year to year and ensures the 12 attainment targets are covered. Each class will cover 5 units (6 for year 3). Units have been chosen to reflect key topics and grammar needed for KS3. Children are mainly taught by their class teacher.</p>	<p><b>Recording-</b> All pupils have exercise books in which knowledge organisers and language builders will be included for each unit. Evidence of activities, different skills and assessments are also included. Books should have a two year cycle. The last unit of each year will focus on writing, with progressive tasks each week.</p>
<p><b>Assessment-</b> Pupils will be assessed on a mixture of skills at the end of each unit. The assessment grid ensures each of the 4 skills are assessed twice a year. Data is entered into the Language Angels site. Teachers can use reports generated from the site and their own professional judgement to compile reports.</p>	<p><b>Vocabulary-</b> Children will learn a wide range of vocabulary throughout KS2, with key vocabulary for each unit available to pupils in class displays, MFL board and exercise books. Essential grammar terminology should also be discussed regularly. Both Language and Grammar are revisited frequently.</p>
<p><b>EYFS-</b> N/A</p>	<p><b>Enrichment-</b> EDL and visitors European Day of Languages is celebrated each year through special assemblies and a focus on bilingual books / library display. Links are being built with local secondary schools to have high school teachers &amp; pupils come to WP to give taster lessons. (This year St Andrews came to teach Spanish to year 5).</p>
<p><b>Adaptation-</b> Children with SEND are able to access the MFL curriculum due to the way language lessons are taught. Lessons include visual resources, lots of repetition, games and songs. All lessons have resources adapted to different levels. As well as covering a unit each half-term, teachers review previous learning regularly to ensure all pupils have an opportunity to embed key vocabulary and phrases.</p>	<p><b>Values-</b> <b>Teamwork</b> Collaborative learning e.g. role play, pair work <b>Independence</b> All activities require children to achieve their best <b>Faith</b> Celebration lessons available on Language Angels showing different cultures <b>Creativity</b> responding to learning through songs, actions and games</p>
