Please see below a link about changes to stagecoach buses in the Worthing area.

This will affect some parents travelling by bus directly to and from school if the pulse is taken away. The other service, number 9 bus that stops at a bus stop nearby runs at 1 bus an hour and it's not the right time for school registration.

If there's no direct bus, parents will have to pay for two bus tickets to change buses. This is expensive for parents.

Looking at the changes, there could be up to a 34 min wait to board the bus for the correct destination by changing buses.

Message From Mrs Bull

Thank you to all the parents who came to our Family Forum this month.

We have representatives from every year group and were able to have really good discussions about 3 areas:

Parents would like more spaces at clubs but were appreciative of the range of clubs on offer. Especially compared to local offers elsewhere.

Mrs Bull said this term we would be better at removing pupils who did not attend clubs from the register and offering that place to another pupil.

Report Format-

Parents reviewed this and were happy with the layout and size. We did discuss the foundation subjects as some felt this could be removed but we would like to retain this as foundation subjects are important part of our school curriculum.

We will endeavour to make the comments as personal as possible and not use the space to reiterate what has been covered as this is on the ½ termly curriculum outline.

PSHE-

The order of units and the vocabulary taught was discussed in detail and we particularly looked at the timing of the units about puberty. Those at Forum felt these could remain in Year 5 and 6 but that we could bring these forward to earlier in the year.

Teachers will bring them slightly forward this year and both units will move to the autumn term next year. Parents will know which units are being studied from the curriculum outline and any resources will be sent home first so parents have an opportunity to read these.
