Pupil Premium Protocol Information for Parents

The pupil premium is additional funding for publicly funded schools in England to raise the attainment of disadvantaged pupils.

The school receives funding for each child registered as eligible for free school meals at any point in the last 6 years and for children who have left local authority care because of adoption, a special quardianship/child arrangements/residence order.

Learning

The priority for the PP funding is support during lessons with additional teaching and resources in order to raise the attainment of the child's learning and ensure every child makes at least good progress from their own starting point.





Across the school, in addition to the whole class Learning Support Assistant and specialist intervention provision, there are Learning Support assistants who work with children who attract the pupil premium to help achieve their learning targets. They support learning in class and also offer pre teaching and reinforcement of new learning as well as targeting any gaps in prior knowledge or understanding. A

large portion on the additional funding is used to provide this level of support.

Additional Support- School trips and enrichment activities

The school can offer some additional support for the children who attract the pupil premium; this can be used in the following ways:



School trips (residential or day trips)



After school clubs run at school Holiday activities/ clubs
